

EU approves fourth vaccine

The European Union has approved Johnson & Johnson's single-shot Janssen vaccine* – J&J's shot joins three other EU-approved vaccines from Pfizer-BioNTech, AstraZeneca-Oxford and Moderna

J&J single-shot vaccine

In large-scale study, vaccine was **72%** protective in U.S., **66%** in South America, and **57%** in South Africa – where new variant has spread



AstraZeneca-Oxford

First dose: **76%**
Second dose: **82.4%**
Interval: **8-12 weeks**



Vaccines require two shots

Pfizer-BioNTech

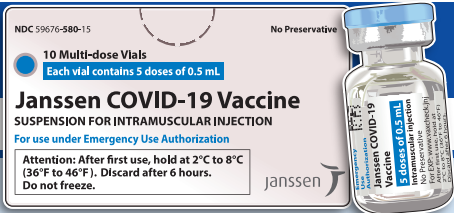
First dose: **62% protection**
Second dose: **92.6% protection**
Interval: **21 days apart**



Moderna vaccine

First dose: **92.1%**
Second dose: **94.1%**
Interval: **28 days**
