▲ The original Apple computer (later known as the Apple I), created by Steve Wozniak and Steve Jobs, was released at an introductory price of \$666.66

1961: The trial of former SS officer Adolf Eichmann began in Jerusalem for his part in war crimes against Jews

2001: The Netherlands became the first country to give terminally ill patients the right to end their lives

2006: Iran officially announced that it had nuclear technology and was able to enrich uranium

2011: France banned the wearing of full face veils in public, sparking protests by Muslims
