*April 13, 1906*

▲ **Samuel Beckett, Irish playwright and poet, was born in Dublin. He lived mostly in France, where he wrote his best-known work, *Waiting for Godot***

**1964:** Sidney Poitier was the first black person to win a Best Actor Oscar, for *Lilies of the Field*

**2010: Eurozone countries agreed an emergency loan facility of €30 billion to bail out Greece**

**2011:** Investigators found 126 bodies in pits in Mexico, blamed on the brutal Zetas and Beltran Leyva drug gangs

**2017: The U.S. Massive Ordnance Air Blast Bomb (MOAB), called the “Mother of all bombs”, was deployed in Afghanistan**
