April 16, 1746

▲ English troops defeated the Jacobite Scots, led by Charles Edward Stuart, or “Bonnie Prince Charlie”, at Culloden, the last pitched battle on British soil

2008: The skeleton of a 65 million year old Triceratops was auctioned in Paris for \$942,000

2016: Pope Francis took 12 Syrian refugees back to the Vatican after visiting a camp in Greece

2017: President Recep Tayyip Erdogan of Turkey won a historic referendum on a package of constitutional changes granting him sweeping new powers

2018: Netflix announced it now had over 125 million subscribers
