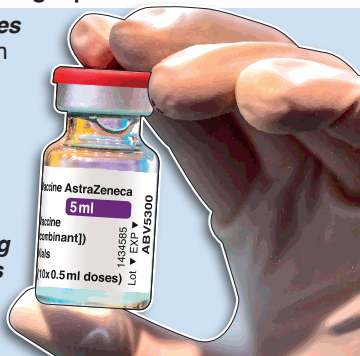


■ Mar 11: European Medicines Agency says number of clots in vaccinated people is no higher than number seen in general population – 30 cases among

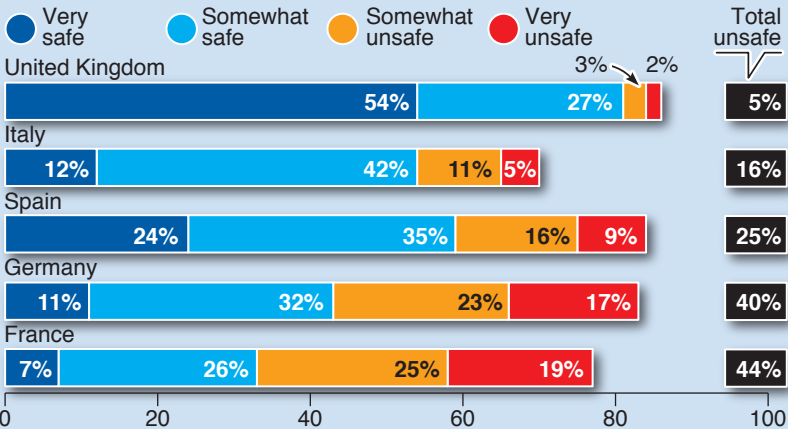
