



# History of the Henri Delaunay Cup



Named in honour of *Henri Delaunay*, the first General Secretary of UEFA who first proposed a pan-European Championship. Delaunay died in 1955, five years before the inaugural tournament



## ORIGINAL TROPHY: 1960-2004

- Designed by *Pierre Delaunay*, Henri's son, and made by *Chobillon* goldsmiths. Trophy is later bought by Paris jeweller *Arthus Bertrand*

- Design bears words *Championnat d'Europe* on front and juggling boy on reverse

## NEW TROPHY: 2008-present

- Remodelled by renowned silversmiths *Asprey of London*. Sterling silver, 18cm taller and 2kg heavier than original, to reflect scale of Europe's most prestigious championships

- *Iker Casillas* is first captain to lift new trophy, as Spain beat Germany in Vienna

- Trophy remains in UEFA's possession – winners receive full-size replica. Team winning three successive titles, or five in total, receives special recognition
