COMBINED EVENT
 Climbers participate in three disciplines: **Speed**, **Bouldering** and **Lead**

SCORING
 Athlete's ranking points from each event are multiplied together to give final score

Example:
5 x 6 x 3 = 90

Lowest score wins

HISTORY
1970s: Sport climbing born in **Verdon Gorge**, France – often referred to as Europe's **Grand Canyon**



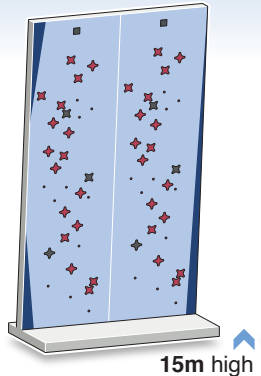
Chalk bag:
 Holds powdered chalk for climber's hands – absorbs sweat and aids grip

Janja Garnbret (SLO), world's greatest Bouldering woman, shown here in Lead event

Shoes: Very tight fitting, to extent of making toes curl. Helps climbers grip onto holds with feet

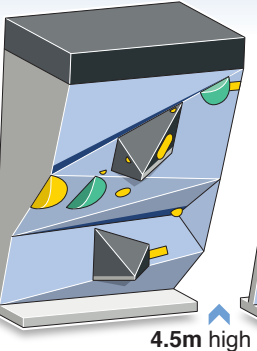
SPEED

Two climbers race up identical courses



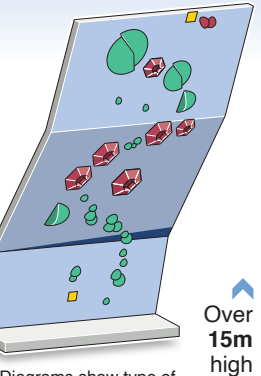
BOULDERING

Climb as many fixed routes as possible within 4 mins



LEAD

Climb as high as possible within 6 mins



Diagrams show type of terrain, not actual courses
