*May 4, 1926*

▲ **The first ever General Strike in Britain began. Over nine days, troops helped maintain essential services, here escorting a food convoy in central London**

**1970:** U.S. National Guardsmen shot dead four student protesters at Kent State University in Ohio

**1972:** A non-governmental environmental group founded in Canada the previous year, changed its name to the “Greenpeace Foundation”

**2004:** Taiwan’s parliament passed a law requiring official documents to be written from left to right

**2005:** A new species of birdlike, feathered dinosaur was discovered
