▲ Red Bull driver Max Verstappen, aged 18, won the Spanish Grand Prix, becoming the youngest ever driver and the first Dutchman to win a Formula One race

1988: The Soviet Union withdrew the first of its estimated 115,000 forces from Afghanistan after nine years

1996: Right-wing leader Atal Bihari Vajpayee became India's first Hindu nationalist prime minister

2007: Canada's Thomson Corporation acquired the Reuters news agency in a deal valued at \$17.2 billion

2018: Russian President Vladimir Putin opened a bridge to Crimea, annexed from Ukraine in 2014
