

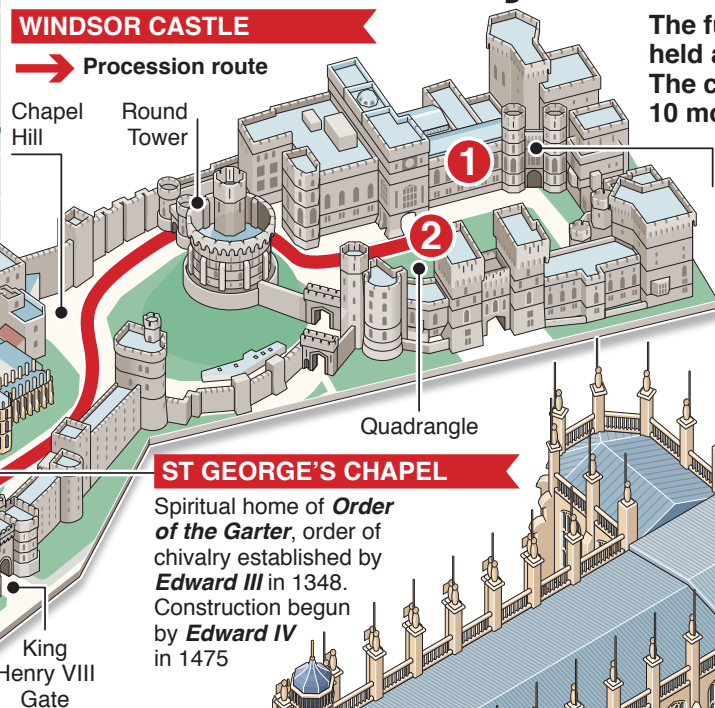
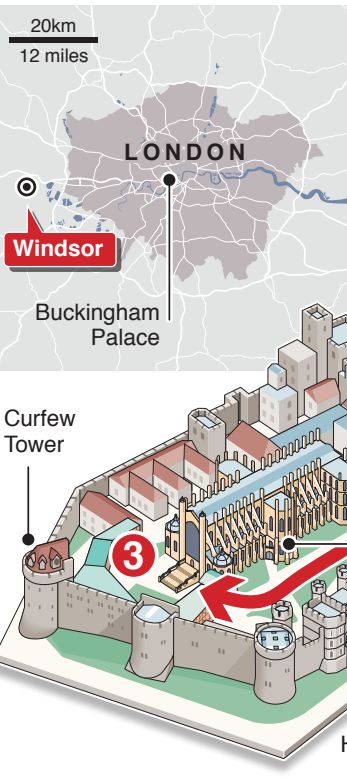
Ceremonial royal funeral for Prince Philip

→ Procession route

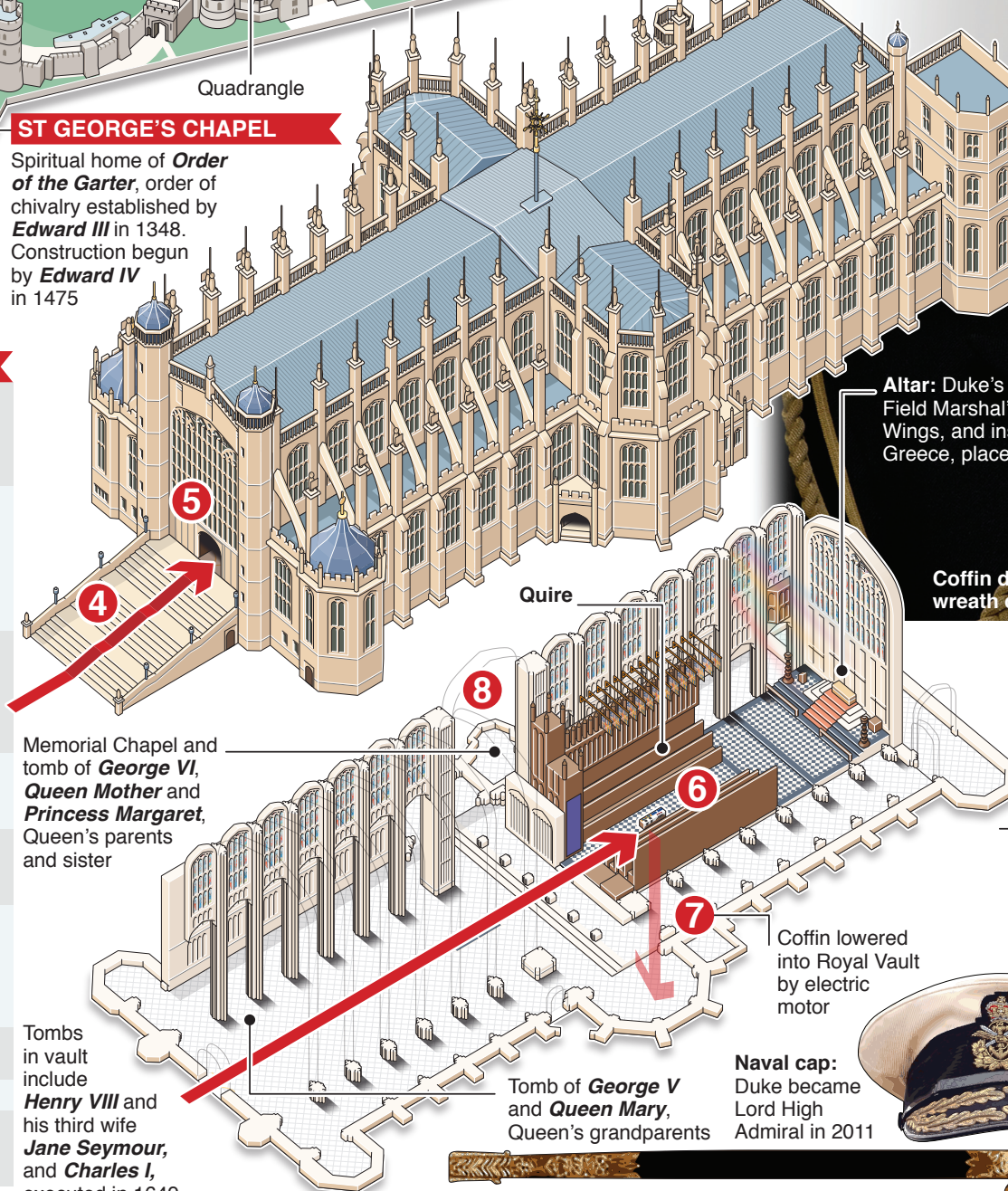
The funeral of the Duke of Edinburgh will be held at St George's Chapel at Windsor Castle. The chapel is the final resting place of 10 monarchs and many royal consorts

ST GEORGE'S CHAPEL

Spiritual home of **Order of the Garter**, order of chivalry established by **Edward III** in 1348. Construction begun by **Edward IV** in 1475



Altar: Duke's medals and decorations, Field Marshal's baton, Royal Air Force Wings, and insignia from Denmark and Greece, placed on cushions on altar

Coffin draped with duke's personal standard, with wreath of flowers and his naval cap and sword

FUNERAL SCHEDULE

- 14.40 local time:** Coffin moved from Private Chapel to Quadrangle and placed on specially modified Land Rover that duke himself helped to design
- 14.45:** Procession begins, led by band of Grenadier Guards, with Land Rover flanked by military pallbearers associated with duke. Members of Royal Family, including **Prince of Wales**, walk behind coffin. **Queen Elizabeth** will travel separately to chapel
- 14.53:** Land Rover arrives at West Steps of St George's Chapel, met by Guard of Honour. National anthem played
- Royal Navy Piping Party pipes nautical calls – "Still" as coffin arrives, and "Side" as it is carried up steps
- 15:00:** Coffin pauses for minute's silence observed nationwide. **Dean of Windsor** and **Archbishop of Canterbury** meet coffin. Only members of Royal Family and duke's private secretary allowed to enter chapel
- Funeral service begins as coffin is carried to Quire, and placed on catafalque
- After service, duke is interred in royal vault
- When Queen dies, Philip will be transferred to **King George VI Memorial Chapel**, to lie alongside his wife of 73 years
