▲ **The first Le Mans 24-hour race was run, on public roads around the French town. It has since evolved into the most famous endurance race in motor sport**

1971: The TU-144, a Soviet version of Concorde, made its first appearance in the West at the Paris Air Show

2006: Europe's largest two-level train station, Berlin Hauptbahnhof, was opened in Germany

2008: China relaxed its one-child policy for parents of the 5,000 children killed in the Sichuan earthquake

2011: Ratko Mladic, ex-Bosnian Serb general believed responsible for the Srebrenica massacre, was arrested
