



## Today in History

*July 7, 1591*

▲ The week-long festival of San Fermin, famous for the “encierro”, or running of the bulls, was established in the Spanish city of Pamplona

**1936:** U.S. patents were issued for the crosshead Phillips screw and matching screwdriver

**1991:** Over 100 prominent Australians formally launched a movement backing the setting up of a republic

**2002:** The WHO warned that 28.5m people in sub-Saharan Africa living with HIV/AIDS could die over the next decade

**2006:** Spain confirmed its first case of H5N1 bird flu and prohibited all transport within a 3km zone
