U.S. President Joe Biden's first big moment on the world stage aims to convince both allies and adversaries that "America is back" after four rocky years under Donald Trump

UK

1 Jun 9: Visits **Royal Air Force Mildenhall** – only permanent U.S. Air Force air refuelling wing in European theatre

2 Jun 10: Meets with Prime Minister **Boris Johnson** in Cornwall before attending **Group of Seven summit** from Jun 11-13

Holds bilateral meetings with **G7** leaders of France, Germany, Italy, Japan and Canada. Australia, India, South Korea and South Africa attend as guests

3 Jun 13: Meets with **Queen Elizabeth** at Windsor Castle, accompanied by First Lady **Jill Biden**

Brussels, BELGIUM

4 Jun 14: Attends **NATO summit**. Meets with Turkish president **Recep Tayyip Erdogan** on sidelines

Jun 15: Attends **U.S.-EU summit**. Meets with Belgium's **King Philippe** and Prime Minister **Alexander De Croo**

Geneva, SWITZERLAND

5 Jun 16: Holds bilateral summit with Russian president **Vladimir Putin**
