

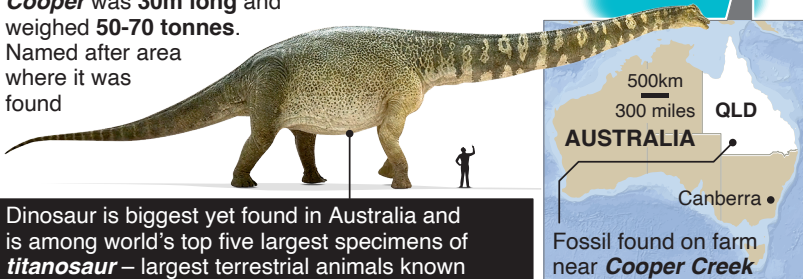
Meet “Cooper”, Australia’s largest dinosaur

Palaeontologists have confirmed that dinosaur fossils found in the Queensland outback in 2006 belong to a new species of giant sauropod

Australotitan cooperensis roamed Earth in **Cretaceous** period (92-96m years ago), when Australia was part of supercontinent of **Gondwana**



Cooper was 30m long and weighed 50-70 tonnes. Named after area where it was found



Dinosaur is biggest yet found in Australia and is among world’s top five largest specimens of **titanosaur** – largest terrestrial animals known
