*July 14, 1881*

▲ U.S. outlaw William Bonney, alias Billy the Kid, was shot dead by Sheriff Pat Garrett in Fort Sumner, New Mexico, while trying to escape capture

**1976:** The Tanzam railway, linking Zambia and Tanzania, began operations

**2008:** Sudan's President Omar al-Bashir was accused of genocide and war crimes in Darfur

**2008:** The stock value of Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac, the largest U.S. issuers of mortgages loans, plunged to 17-year lows

**2016:** A truck ploughed into a crowd of revellers celebrating Bastille Day in Nice, France, killing 84 people
