▲ **The Sagarmatha National Park in Nepal, which includes Mount Everest, was created. The Nepali name for Everest is Sagarmatha, or Goddess of the Sky**

1941: British Prime Minister Winston Churchill adopted his “V for Victory” campaign in World War II

2001: Mount Etna began erupting in Sicily, with high speed lava flows threatening the town of Nicolosi

2006: A house believed to be the birthplace of Augustus, the first emperor of ancient Rome, was discovered

2019: Iran captured a British oil tanker in the Strait of Hormuz after British troops seized an Iranian ship
