Competition format
Single-elimination tournament, with winner of each match advancing to next round

Duration
Match consists of three, three-minute rounds

Six-time world champion
MC Mary Kom (IND)

Gloves: Boxer scores points for successful hits to opponent's head or torso. Hitting below belt or on back of head is prohibited

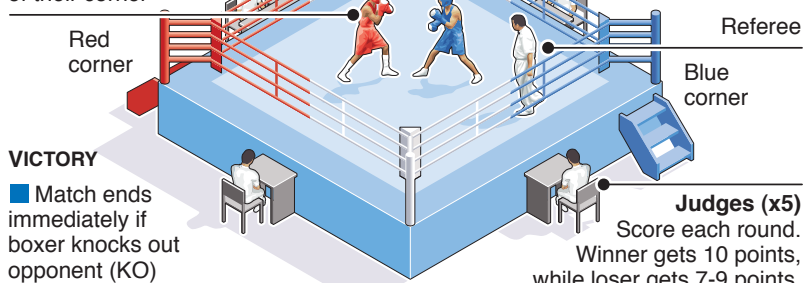
Headgear
Mandatory for female boxers

Boxers: Wear red or blue to match colour of their corner

Ring: 6.1 sq metres (inside ropes)



VICTORY

- Match ends immediately if boxer knocks out opponent (KO)
- Matches that last entire three rounds are decided on points
- If referee stops contest – when one boxer is deemed unfit to continue, retires or is disqualified

Judges (x5)

Score each round. Winner gets 10 points, while loser gets 7-9 points. Scores added at end of match to decide overall winner on points

Judging criteria

Punches on target, technique, tactics, competitiveness and dominance
