▲ The England football team, captained by Bobby Moore, beat West Germany 4-2 to win the FIFA World Cup final at London's Wembley Stadium

2001: Canada became the first country in the world to legalise the use of marijuana for medical purposes

2003: The last original-style Volkswagen Beetle, number 21,529,464, rolled off its assembly line in Puebla, Mexico

2015: The Afghan Taliban confirmed the death of its leader, Mullah Omar
