August 29, 1896

▲ **The Chinese-American dish chop suey – meat and eggs cooked quickly with vegetables in a starch-thickened sauce – was invented in New York City**

1831: British scientist Michael Faraday successfully demonstrated the first electrical transformer

1966: The Beatles played their last live concert at Candlestick Park, California, to a 25,000-strong crowd

1991: The Soviet parliament suspended all Communist Party activities after an attempted coup

2017: North Korea fired a Hwasong-12 missile over Japan, a move described as an “unprecedented” threat
