▲ **Spanish settlers founded Los Angeles; its full title El Pueblo de Nuestra Senora La Reina de Los Angeles (The Town of Our Lady The Queen of The Angels)**

1886: Apache chief Geronimo, leader of the last great Native American rebellion, surrendered in Arizona

2006: Australian naturalist Steve Irwin died from a stingray barb while filming on the Great Barrier Reef

2008: The reassembled 1,700-year-old Obelisk of Axum, taken to Italy as war booty in 1937, was unveiled in Ethiopia

2016: Pro-independence activists won seats in Hong Kong's legislative elections after a record voter turnout
