# Terrorism after 9/11

Since the 9/11 attacks, no foreign terrorist organization has successfully mounted a deadly attack against the United States, but jihadists and other extremists have launched multiple deadly attacks around the globe



## 1. Sep 11, 2001: U.S

Al Qaeda terrorists hijack four airliners, crashing two into World Trade Centre and third plane into Pentagon. Fourth plane crashes in Pennsylvania. Attacks kill 2,977 people

## 2. Oct 12, 2002: Indonesia

Triple bombings by Jemaah Islamiyah kill 202 people and injure further 209 on island of Bali

## 3. Oct 22-26, 2002: Russia

Chechen separatists seize 850 hostages in Moscow's Dubrovka Theatre. At least 170 people are killed when special forces storm theatre

## 4. Mar 11, 2004: Spain

Al Qaeda-inspired bombings against Madrid commuter trains kill 192 people and injure around 2,000

## 5. Sep 1-3, 2004: Russia

Beslan school siege ends with at least 385 dead, mostly children



## 6. Jul 7, 2005: UK

Four Islamist suicide bomb attacks in central London kill 52 civilians, 700 injured

## 7. Jul 11, 2005: India

Seven coordinated bomb blasts on Mumbai railway kill 209 people, 700 injured

## 8. Nov 26-29, 2008: India

Shooting and bomb attacks in Mumbai, kill 164 people, wound more than 300

## 9. Jul 11, 2011: Norway

Two sequential attacks – car bomb in Oslo and shooting on Utøya island – kill 77 people and injure 319

## 10. Sep 21, 2013: Kenya

Al Qaeda-linked Al Shabaab gunmen attack Westgate shopping mall in Nairobi, killing 67 people and wounding more than 175

## 11. Dec 16, 2014: Pakistan

Taliban gunmen kill 132 children and nine adults at army-run school in Peshawar

## 12. Jan 7, 2015: France

Two gunmen attack offices of satirical newspaper Charlie Hebdo in Paris, killing 12 people. Shooters then kill five others in Île-de-France region

## 13. Nov 13, 2015: France

Gunmen and suicide bombers kill 130 people and injure 368 in Paris

## 14. Mar 22, 2016: Belgium

Coordinated attacks in Brussels by Islamic State kill 32 people and injure over 300 others

## 16. May 22, 2017: UK

Suicide bombing at Manchester Arena kills 22 people, injures 119



## 17. Aug 17, 2017: Spain

Van and knife attacks in Barcelona and Cambrils claim lives of 15 people, injure 130

## 18. Mar 15, 2019: New Zealand

White supremacist gunman kills 51 people, injures 49 at two mosques in Christchurch

## 19. Dec 6, 2019: U.S.

Jihadist attack at Naval Air Station Pensacola. Three people shot dead – Al Qaeda in Arabian Peninsula claims responsibility
