▲ **Israeli Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin and Palestinian leader Yasser Arafat shook hands at the White House after signing a historic peace agreement**

1966: Far right Nationalist politician John Vorster was sworn in as prime minister of South Africa

1971: New York state police stormed Attica prison to end a five-day revolt; 31 prisoners and 11 guards died

1989: Archbishop Desmond Tutu led the biggest anti-apartheid march in South Africa for 30 years

2001: Wealthy Saudi exile Osama bin Laden was named as the prime suspect behind the 9/11 attacks
