▲ **U.S. President Jimmy Carter, Anwar Sadat of Egypt and Menachem Begin of Israel reached a framework for a peace treaty at their summit at Camp David**

1871: The Mont Cenis Tunnel from France to Italy was the first of the great tunnels through the Alps to be opened

1931: RCA Victor demonstrated the first long-playing record to rotate at 33-1/3 rpm in New York

1991: Latvia, Lithuania, Estonia, both Koreas, Micronesia and the Marshall Islands were admitted to the UN

2001: The U.S. stock market reopened after the 9/11 terror attacks, falling 14.3% that week
