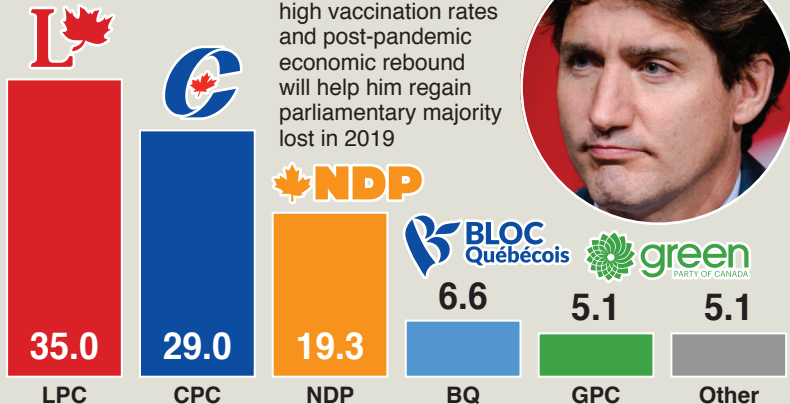


# Canada heads to snap election

Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau has triggered an election on September 20, two years ahead of schedule, as polls suggest his minority Liberal government looks within reach of forming a majority
