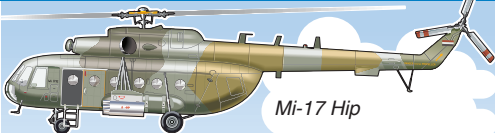


Taliban's U.S.-funded war chest

From 2002, the U.S. gave the Afghan military an estimated \$76 billion in weaponry, including aircraft, armoured vehicles and guns.

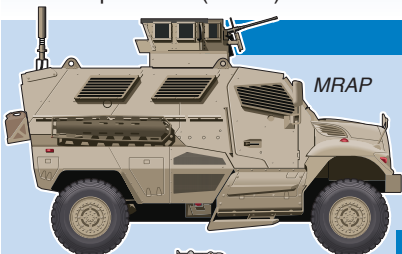
