*September 23, 1846*

▲ German astronomer Johann Galle first observed the planet Neptune, alerted by French mathematician Urbain Le Verrier who had predicted its position

**1913:** French aviator Roland Garros made the first non-stop flight across the Mediterranean Sea

**1953:** WD-40, an oil that displaced water to prevent rust, was invented

**2019:** Thomas Cook, the world's oldest travel agency, entered compulsory liquidation

**2020:** Harold Evans, British-American editor whose 70-year career set the gold standard for investigative journalism, died at 92
