▲ **Shimon Peres, former Prime Minister and President of Israel, died at 93. He won the 1994 Nobel Peace Prize for his efforts to reach a peace deal with the Palestinians**

1066: William, Duke of Normandy, France, landed at Pevensey, beginning the Norman Conquest of England

2004: The price of oil surged past the \$50 milestone for the first time

2006: Bangkok's Suvarnabhumi International Airport opened, with the world's then largest terminal building

2016: A Dutch investigation concluded Malaysia Airlines flight MH17 was shot down by a missile brought into Ukraine from Russia
