

Ida kills dozens across U.S. north-east

Three days after Hurricane Ida made landfall in Louisiana, its remnants hit the U.S. north-east, claiming at least 46 lives in what President Biden called climate-related destruction

Sep 2: Storm Ida brings flash flooding and tornadoes, killing at least 23 people in New Jersey and 14 in New York City – most of them stuck in vehicles or trapped in flooded basements

Aug 29: Ida smashes into Louisiana as Category 4 hurricane with record 241km/hr winds, leaving more than 1 million people without power and killing at least six.

Damage estimated to cost \$18 billion

Aug 27: Ida makes landfall in Cuba as Category 1 hurricane
