

Singapore lifts 737 Max flight ban

Singapore has lifted the operational ban on Boeing's 737 Max that was imposed more than two years ago, leaving China as the only major market where regulators are yet to give the plane a green light

Passenger jet grounded worldwide in Mar 2019 after two fatal crashes – began gradual return to service in Dec 2020



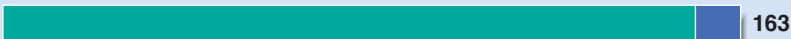

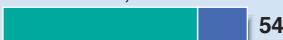

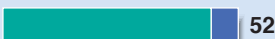

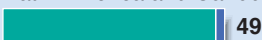

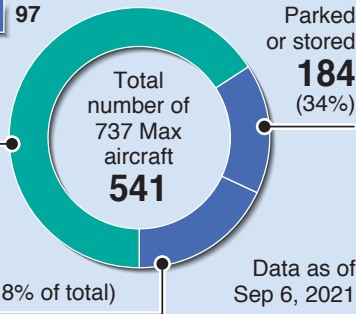
