

# Timeline of the 2015 Paris terror attacks

Twenty men are accused of having roles in the so-called Islamic State group's 2015 attacks in Paris that killed 130 people and wounded hundreds of others – France's worst post-war atrocity

## Nov 13, 2015

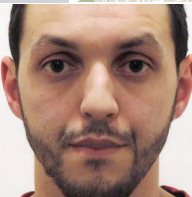
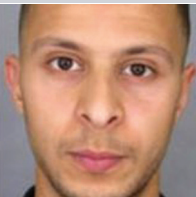
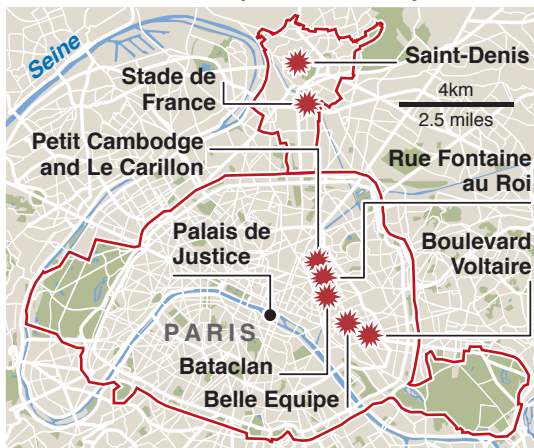
### 21:20 local time

Attacks begin with three suicide bombers blowing themselves up outside **Stade de France**. Security guard also killed

### 21:24-21:40

39 people killed in shootings at bars and restaurants in **10th and 11th arrondissements**

**21:40:** Three gunmen storm **Bataclan concert hall**, killing 90

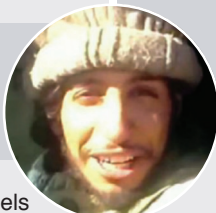


*Salah Abdeslam (far left) – believed to be only surviving member of group directly involved in Paris attacks – and Mohamed Abrini (left)*

**Nov 14:** Special forces enter Bataclan, two terrorists blow themselves up, third is shot dead. **Salah Abdeslam**, who had dropped off stadium bombers, flees to Belgium. So-called Islamic State claims responsibility for attacks

**Nov 17-18:** Alleged mastermind of attacks, **Abdelhamid Abaaoud (right)**, killed in police raid on house in **Saint-Denis**

**Mar 18, 2016:** Salah Abdeslam captured in Brussels



**Mar 22:** Three suicide bombers, connected to Paris attacks, kill 32 people in Brussels

**Apr 8:** **Mohamed Abrini**, suspected of being involved in Paris attacks and Brussels bombings, is arrested in Belgium

**Sep 8, 2021:** Trial begins in Paris of 20 men accused over Paris attacks. Abrini, Abdeslam and 12 others set to appear. Five defendants are presumed dead and one is on run

**May 25, 2022:** Judges expected to deliver their verdict
