▲ **The European Commission ruled only cheese made in Greece could be called feta, and that non Greek feta-style cheeses must be marketed under another name**

2004: Vladimir Putin and Hu Jintao demarcated the 4,345km (2,700-mile) border between Russia and China

2006: The UN unanimously approved sanctions on North Korea

2009: WWW creator Tim Berners-Lee apologised for the “unnecessary” forward slashes in internet addresses

2019: Protests erupted in Barcelona after nine Catalan separatist leaders were jailed over the failed 2017 independence bid
