▲ **Pablo Picasso, one of the greatest artists of the 20th century, was born. Famous works include Les Femmes d'Alger (1907), and Guernica (1937)**

1936: Germany broadcast the first radio request programme

1971: The People's Republic of China replaced the Republic of China (Taiwan) at the United Nations

1976: Transkei became the first of South Africa's black homelands to be granted its independence

2020: Formula 1 driver Lewis Hamilton won a world record 92nd career victory, surpassing Michael Schumacher's tally of 91
