

Race to succeed Duterte in Philippines

President Rodrigo Duterte's surprise retirement from politics when his term ends in 2022 clears the way for his daughter Sara Duterte-Carpio to run for the presidency



◀ **Sara Duterte-Carpio, 43**
Succeeded her father (*right*) as mayor of city of Davao in 2010. Frontrunner in all recent polls but has given mixed messages about running for high office

Analysts believe that as president, she would likely protect Duterte from legal action by International Criminal Court over thousands of extrajudicial killings during his "war on drugs"



◀ **Ferdinand "Bongbong" Marcos Jr., 64**
Ex-senator
Son and namesake of former dictator offers "unifying" brand of leadership to heal Philippines after Covid-19 crisis



◀ **Isko Moreno, 46**
Manila City mayor
Born **Francisco Domagoso** in slums and scavenged for food in childhood before becoming film star in 1990s. Now known by his screen name



◀ **Manny Pacquiao, 42**
Senator
Boxing legend recently retired from ring to run for presidency. Pledges to campaign against poverty and corruption



Senator **Panfilo Lacson** has also confirmed his candidacy



Candidacy officially filed
