▲ **“Dr Livingstone, I presume?”, enquired journalist Henry Stanley on finding missing Scottish explorer David Livingstone at Ujiji, in present day Tanzania**

1957: Part of the Great Wall of China opened to tourists for the first time. It was built between 1368 and 1644
