▲ **Route 66, one of America's most famous roads, was established. It ran from Chicago to Los Angeles, a distance of 2,448 miles (3,940km) through eight states**

1675: German mathematician Gottfried Leibniz demonstrated integral calculus for the first time

1790: Chrysanthemums were introduced into Europe from China, where they were cultivated as a flowering herb

2001: Taiwan joined the World Trade Organisation, one day after China

2017: The Louvre Abu Dhabi opened, the first museum of its kind in the Arab world
