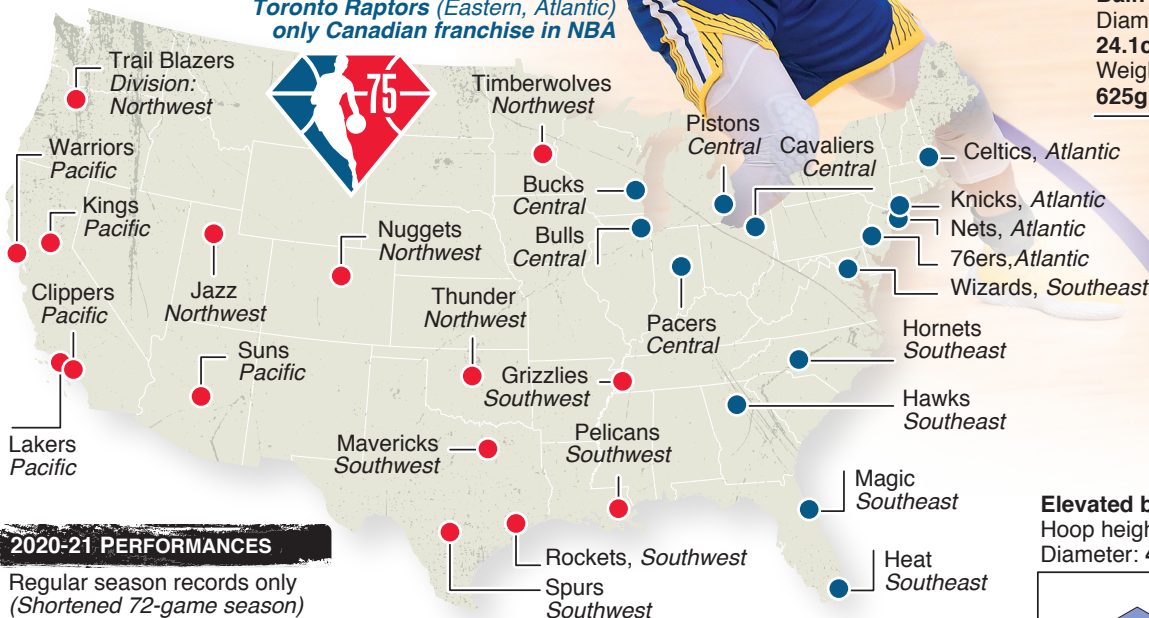

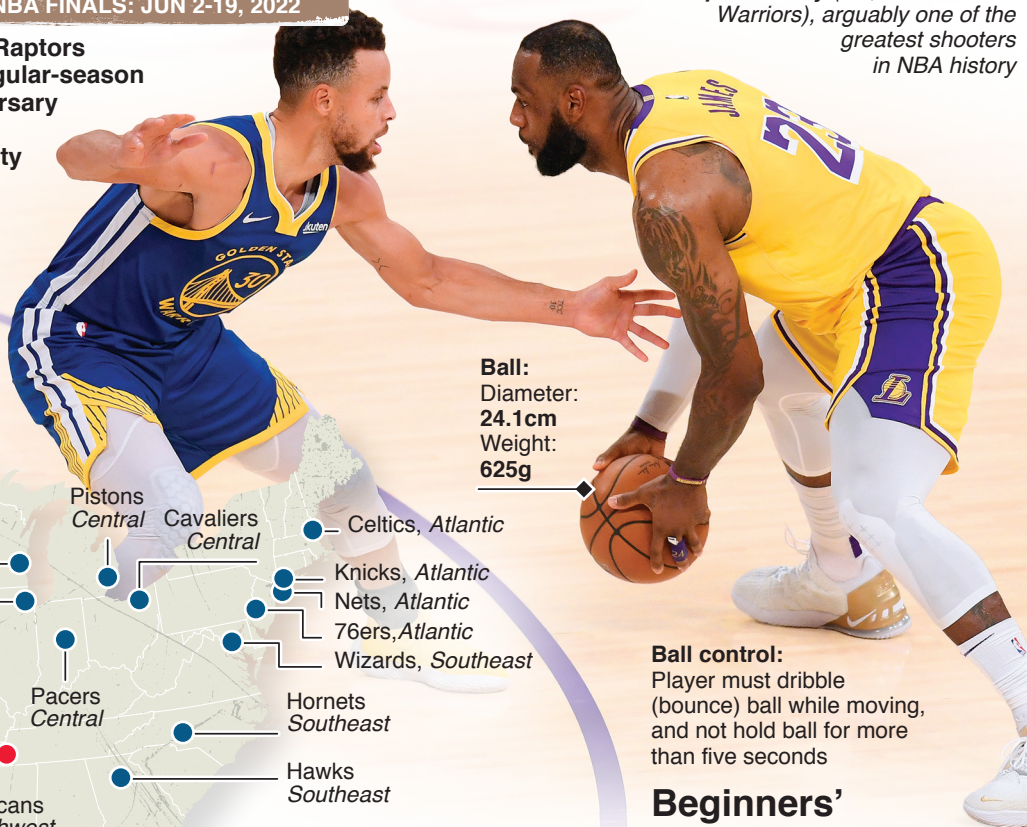

Ball:
Diameter: 24.1cm
Weight: 625g

Ball control:
Player must dribble (bounce) ball while moving, and not hold ball for more than five seconds

Beginners' guide to basketball

Attacking team: Must get ball in opposing half within eight seconds and make shot at basket within 24 seconds

Free throw line:
Up to three throws awarded for fouls

Three-point line

No-charge semi-circle

Elevated basket:
Hoop height: 3.05m
Diameter: 45cm



Key: Attacking player may not stay in this area for more than three seconds

Playing time

Four 12-minute quarters, followed by five-minute overtime periods if scores are tied

Scoring

Free throw: 1pt

Inside three-point line: 2pts

Outside three-point line: 3pts
