▲ **The Warsaw Ghetto was walled off, sealing in more than 400,000 Jewish residents, many of whom were subsequently deported to Nazi extermination camps**

1942: The wartime movie *Casablanca*, ranked as one of the greatest films ever made, opened in New York

1966: The world's first tidal power station was opened in France at the Rance estuary in Brittany

2001: A U.S. firm claimed to have cloned the first human embryo for use in medical research

2011: NASA launched the robotic Mars Science Laboratory, the largest rover yet sent to the Red Planet
