

Global struggle to curb emissions

Together, China, the U.S., EU and India are responsible for more than 60% of global carbon emissions. While the U.S. and EU are cutting CO₂ use, China and India expect their emissions to keep rising

Carbon dioxide-equivalent emissions (gigatonnes*) **47.6-50.7 est.** 14

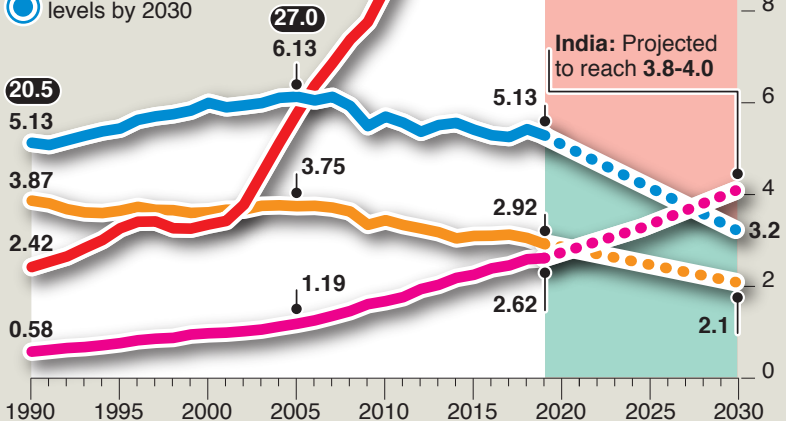
China U.S. EU India Projections

Emissions reduction goals

Dec 2020: EU increases emissions reduction target to 55% below 1990 levels by 2030

Apr 2021: U.S. sets target of 50-52% below 2005 levels by 2030
