December 7, 1941

▲ **Japanese planes attacked the U.S. Pacific fleet at Pearl Harbour, Hawaii, killing over 2,400 people and leading the United States to declare war on Japan**

1911: A Chinese edict abolished the wearing of pigtails

1996: Algeria introduced constitutional reforms which banned political parties based on religion or language

2001: Kandahar, the last Taliban stronghold in Afghanistan, fell to local Afghan forces

2015: Republican presidential frontrunner Donald Trump called for a ban on Muslims entering the U.S.
