Twelve years ago, developed nations pledged to provide US\$100 billion a year to poorer countries by 2020 to help them adapt to climate change.

So far, rich countries have fallen short

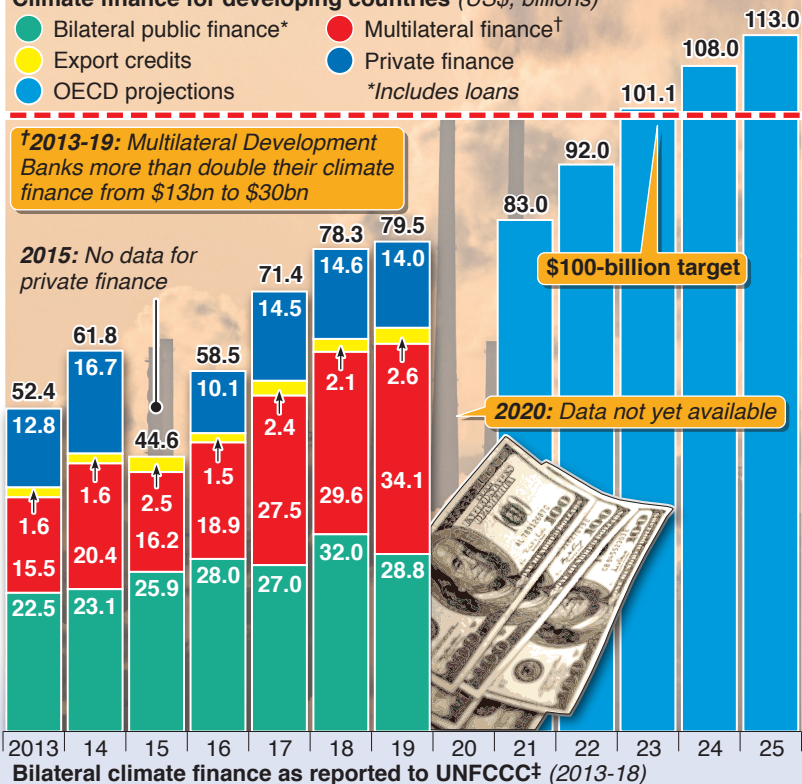
Climate finance for developing countries (US\$, billions)

†2013-19: Multilateral Development Banks more than double their climate finance from \$13bn to \$30bn

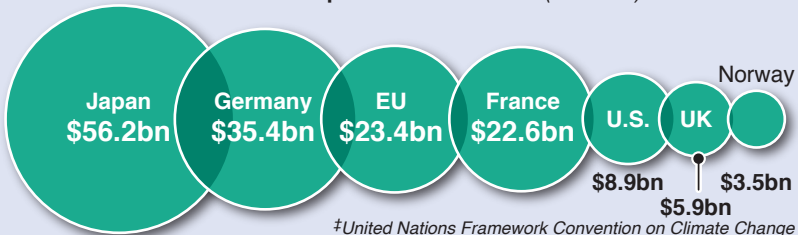
