▲ **Deposed Iraqi President Saddam Hussein was executed after being convicted of crimes against humanity in the 1982 murders of 148 Iraqi Shias in Dujail**

1916: The Siberian mystic Rasputin was murdered by Russian nobles

2006: The Basque separatist group Eta staged a bomb attack that killed two people at Madrid's Barajas airport

2008: A vast dinosaur fossil site, a 300m-long pit containing 7,600 bones, was found near Zhucheng, China

2020: The EU and the United Kingdom signed an agreement governing their relationship after Brexit
