1946: U.S. President Harry S. Truman formally declared an end to all hostilities in the Second World War

2006: The death of a Texan soldier in Baghdad brought the number of U.S. troops killed in Iraq to 3,000

2011: A Chinese bus driver died from bird flu in the city of Shenzhen in Guangdong province
