

Prominent people held by Myanmar junta

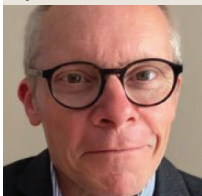
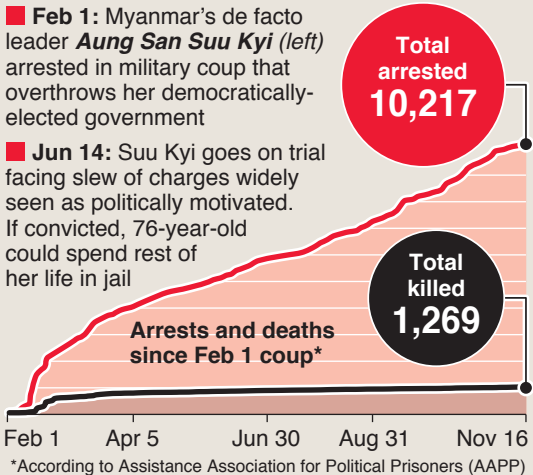
More than 10,000 people have been arrested and over 1,200 have been killed in Myanmar since the military seized power in February, according to a local monitoring group



■ **Feb 1:** Myanmar's de facto leader **Aung San Suu Kyi** (left) arrested in military coup that overthrows her democratically-elected government

■ **Jun 14:** Suu Kyi goes on trial facing slew of charges widely seen as politically motivated. If convicted, 76-year-old could spend rest of her life in jail

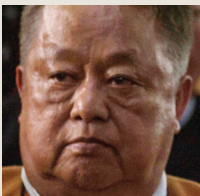
■ **Nov 16:** Military authorities add electoral fraud charges, accusing Suu Kyi of abuse of power relating to 2020 polls her party won by landslide

Win Myint
Myanmar's president ousted and arrested on Feb 1. Faces charges including incitement and sedition



Win Htein
Senior member of Suu Kyi's party sentenced in October to 20 years in prison on charges of high treason

U.S. journalist – one of over 100 detained media workers – freed on Nov 15 after nearly six months in prison
