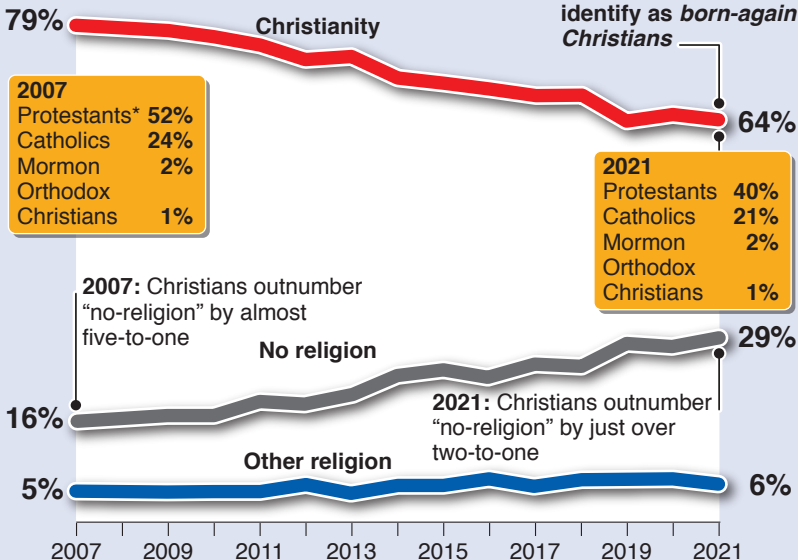


Non-religious surge in United States

According to the Pew Research Centre, the number of Americans who identify as non-religious is soaring in the profoundly Christian U.S., with about three in 10 adults religiously unaffiliated
