**1839:** Pioneering French photographer Louis Daguerre took the first picture of the moon

**1992:** Food prices in Russia rose sharply when state controls were lifted and subsidies reduced

**1994:** Astronomers discovered a new galaxy at the edge of the universe, around 13 billion light years away

**2012:** Protests erupted in Hungary over moves by Prime Minister Viktor Orban that undermined democracy
