▲ Scientists reported evidence of lakes filled with liquid methane on Saturn's moon Titan. It was the first discovery of existing lakes anywhere apart from Earth

1932: Japanese troops occupying Manchuria reached the eastern end of the Great Wall of China

2004: Former justice minister Mikhail Saakashvili won 96% of the vote in Georgia's presidential election

2010: The Burj Khalifa, at 825m the tallest structure ever built, was opened in Dubai

2012: The EU embargoed Iranian oil to put pressure on Tehran to halt uranium enrichment
