▲ **Arkansas teacher Hattie Ophelia Caraway became the first woman elected to the U.S. Senate. She was re-elected in 1938 and left office in 1945**

1957: Elvis Presley recorded All Shook Up. It topped the U.S. pop chart for eight weeks

1967: Dr James Bedford became the first person to be cryopreserved after death

1977: Anti-French demonstrations took place in Israel after Paris released Abu Daoud, who led the massacre of Israeli athletes at the 1972 Munich Olympics

1992: Russia and Ukraine agreed to divide the Black Sea fleet
