

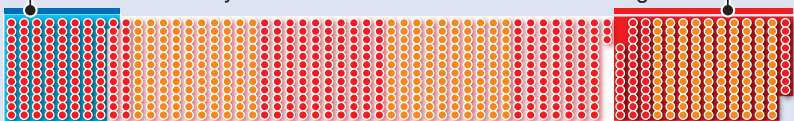
Few jailed since U.S. Capitol riots

Federal prosecutors have charged over 720 people since supporters of President Donald Trump stormed the U.S. Capitol in January 2021 in a bid to stop Congress from certifying Joe Biden's election victory

1 Robert Scott Palmer: Pleads guilty to assaulting police defending Capitol with wooden plank and fire extinguisher. Sentence: **63 months in prison**

2 Scott Kevin Fairlamb: Pleads guilty to assaulting police officer and obstructing Electoral College proceedings following election. **41 months in prison**

3 Jacob A. Chansley: So-called **QAnon shaman** pleads guilty to felony for obstructing official Senate proceedings. **41 months in prison**

4 Paul Allard Hodgkins: Pleads guilty to one felony count of entering Capitol building to obstruct official proceedings. **Eight months in prison**
