▲ Scientists in Scotland reported successfully creating the first clone of an adult mammal, a sheep called Dolly, using the technique of somatic cell nuclear transfer

1987: Andy Warhol, the most famous protagonist of “Pop Art”, died

1992: The European Community backed proposals to halt production and use of chemicals damaging the ozone layer

2007: New Zealand fishermen caught the largest colossal squid ever found

2017: Astronomers detected seven Earth-sized exoplanets orbiting the star Trappist-1, three of them in its habitable zone
