▲ Time magazine was launched in the United States. It has the largest circulation for a weekly news magazine, with a global readership of 26 million

1802: Beethoven's Moonlight Sonata was published

1938: A New Zealand mining engineer discovered oil in Saudi Arabia

1991: Latvia and Estonia, which had broken away from the Soviet Union, voted for independence in referendums

2003: Members of the Greek terror group November 17 went on trial in Athens for 23 murders including diplomats and military officials
